1.0 Introduction

Academic Achievement is defined by crow and crow (1969)

"The extent to which a learner is Profiting from instruction in a given area of learning. i.e.- achievement is reflected by the extent to which skill and knowledge has been imparted to him".

Academic achievement is influenced by personality, motivation, opportunities, Education and training. There are several other factors also which influence the academic achievement of students like study habit, Intelligence, socio-economic status and self concept etc.

Intelligence is been traditionally been considered as important predictor of academic achievement. Intelligence was defined in term of ability to do abstract reasoning, ability to learn and ability to adapt in novel situations. The recent views of Intelligence recognize active role of an intelligent person in terms of shaping and selecting an environment according to his/her choice. It is a manifestation of cognitive ability with reference to ones academic achievement.

According to stern,

"Intelligence is a general capacity of an individual consciously to adjust his thinking to new requirements". It is the general mental adaptability to new problems and conditions of life.

Study habits, Intelligence and academic achievement are the three major pillars of educational building. All these three give supports to the building. If one is weak then ultimately the pressure should be taken by others. Hence all the three pillars should be very strong so that the educational building becomes automatically strong.Not only the study habit has an influence on academic achievement but also Intelligence. All three are interdependent to each other. We can't neglect any one of the above. If an individual has too much Intelligent he must do good Study Habit and have good Academic Achievement. Individuals having not good Academic Achievement means either they neglect to their study habit or have less Intelligence or both.

1.1 Need of the Study:

Academic achievement is the main focus of the educative process to improve the learning and performance of the pupils. The academic achievements are the criteria for assessing their learning outcomes. It is the process of measuring the behavioral change of the students at the end of any instruction. This parameter categorizes the students as slow, average and first learners. 1.2 Statement of the Problem

The present study will be undertaken with an objective that the research findings would help to identify the common errors following a particular pattern committed by learner while solving the problems on educational achievement.

1.3 Definitions of Operational Terms to be used in study:

- INTELLIGENCE Intelligence is the ability to do abstract reasoning ability to learn and ability to adapt in novel situations. It is a manifestation of cognitive ability with reference to ones academic achievement.
- 2. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT It is defined as the level of academic performance with performance being evaluated using examination results. In this study the previous year marks certificates of the pupil teachers would serve as the academic achievement.
- B.Ed. PUPIL TEACHERS Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) is a teacher training course meant for preparing teachers for secondary schools. The trainees who are pursuing their B.Ed. training are taken as B.Ed. pupil teachers in this study.

1.4 Objectives of the Study

1.5 Hypothesis of the study
