Abstract

Teachers are the key steerers in the journey of education and are one of the most prominent pillars of this system. Education, in its broadest sense, is a process of self-realisation and thus demands effective teachers to help learners realise it in its truest sense. Teacher effectiveness has been defined differently by various researchers with the crux being that it is a cocktail of multiple factors like inter-personal skills, cognitive abilities, pedagogical knowledge, competencies, attitudes, behaviours, and other observable characteristics. This is a study to identify the impact of the following factorsteacher's years of experience, gender, and the nature of the school she teaches in on the level of her effectiveness. Effectiveness scores of 80 secondary school teachers teaching in government and private schools of Lucknow, UP was calculated using the Teacher Effectiveness scale by Dr Umme Kulsum. Results of the study revealed that only the years of experience a teacher had was a significant contributor to her effectiveness levels. While the other two factors- gender and the nature of the school were insignificant in terms of their impact on her effectiveness scores.

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
