
National Youth Day Celebration 12 Jan 2025

The Regional Institute of Bhopal witnessed a vibrant celebration of National Youth Day on January 12, 2025, commemorating the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda at RIE Auditorium. The event, highlighted in a blended mode, saw the active participation of more than 100 students online, along with students and staff gathered in the RIE Auditorium. The occasion was graced by the esteemed presence of Maharaj Nitya Gyananand Ji from Ramakrishna Mission, Bhopal. The program began with a warm Swagat Bhashan (welcome speech) by Dr. Saurabh Kumar, Chief Advisor of the Student Council. He eloquently emphasized Swami Vivekananda's advocacy for inclusive education and vocational training. He also highlighted the alignment of these ideals with the objectives of NEP 2020. Prof. Jaydip Mandal, the Principal, stressed the importance of eliminating discrimination and aligning actions with intentions. He inspired the audience with his message that with pure intentions, any goal can be achieved. Dr. Suresh Makwana, Head of DESSH, spoke about Swami Vivekananda's vision of integrating traditional knowledge systems with modern education. He emphasized the belief in "Jan Seva Hi Ishwar Seva Hai" (Service to humanity is service to God) and elaborated on Advaita Darshan (non-dualism) as guided by Swami Vivekananda. Dr. Ramesh Babu, who joined the program online, discussed Swami Vivekananda's efforts to synthesize Western science and Eastern spirituality. He elaborated on the concept of non-duality at the spiritual level and its relevance in achieving harmony between science and spirituality. Maharaj Nitya Gyananand Ji elaborated on the significance of celebrating National Youth Day. He spoke about the two types of knowledge—objective and subjective—and their importance in the context of NEP 2020. He recommended three essential books by Swami Vivekananda for students:

1. Life of Swami Vivekananda

Maharaj Ji also encouraged teachers to help manifest the inherent potential within students through practice, concentration, and discipline. The students contributed significantly to the

Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Jayanti on 23/01/2025

The institute celebrated the birth anniversary of **Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose** with great enthusiasm and patriotic fervor. The programme was organized to pay homage to one of India's most iconic freedom fighters and to inspire the younger generation with his indomitable spirit, leadership, and vision. Students, faculty, and invited guests participated actively in the event, making it a memorable occasion.

Programme Highlights

The programme began with a **documentary** by **Studio RIE, Bhopal**, which captured the remarkable journey of Netaji—from his early education and civil service success to his eventual emergence as a revolutionary leader. The documentary effectively highlighted his unwavering commitment to India's independence and his courageous steps to mobilize an armed resistance through the **Azad Hind Fauj (Indian National Army)**.

Following the documentary, students gave a **PowerPoint presentation** on the **life and philosophy of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose**. The presentation included key milestones in Netaji's life:

- His birth on **23rd January 1897** in Cuttack, Odisha.
- His brilliance as a student and selection into the **Indian Civil Services**, which he resigned from to serve the freedom movement.
- His ideological conflict with the Congress leadership and the formation of the **Forward Bloc**.
- His travels to Germany, Japan, and Southeast Asia to form the **Azad Hind Government** in exile.
- The raising of the **INA**, and his stirring slogan: *"Give me blood, and I will give you freedom."*

Students elaborated on Netaji's vision of a **strong, united, and self-reliant India**, and how his actions demonstrated the power of bold leadership.

Keynote Address by Prof. K.K. Khare

Topic: “*Legacy and Contemporary Relevance of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose*”

The highlight of the event was the **keynote address** by **Prof. K.K. Khare**, former Principal of **RIE Bhopal**, who provided an insightful and scholarly overview of Netaji's contributions and the relevance of his philosophy in today's world.

Prof. Khare emphasized that **Netaji was a visionary, not merely a revolutionary**. He reflected on how Netaji's ideals are deeply needed in modern India and offered key insights into his thoughts and their current relevance:

1. Patriotism in Practice

Netaji was a man of action. He transformed patriotic sentiment into meaningful deeds, forming the INA to physically challenge British rule. Prof. Khare called for a similar transformation in today's youth—turning passion for the nation into **community service, innovation, and social reform**.

2. Leadership Rooted in Sacrifice

Netaji's leadership was based not on position, but **on selflessness, sacrifice, and moral integrity**. Prof. Khare urged students to aspire toward leadership that is **value-driven**, not self-serving.

3. National Unity Above All

The Indian National Army was a shining example of **unity in diversity**. Hindus, Muslims, Sikhs, and Christians fought together under Netaji's command. In today's context of social divisions, Prof. Khare highlighted the **urgency of fostering inclusive nationalism**.

4. Educational Empowerment

Netaji emphasized the need for **education that builds character, courage, and responsibility**. Prof. Khare advocated for an education system that goes beyond academics and nurtures **ethical leadership, social awareness, and national pride**.

5. Resistance Against Injustice

Netaji was never afraid to stand against injustice, whether from colonial rulers or within the national leadership. Prof. Khare encouraged students to **develop the courage to speak out and stand up** against inequality, corruption, and social wrongs.

6. Global Vision with Indian Soul

Netaji built international coalitions while remaining deeply Indian in thought. Prof. Khare stressed that India today needs **global citizens with a rooted identity**, able to interact with the world while preserving their cultural ethos.

Prof. Khare concluded by stating:

“Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose belongs not just to history, but to the future. He is a symbol of what India can be—strong, united, courageous, and morally elevated.”

His address left a deep impact on students and faculty alike, sparking reflections on personal responsibility and national service.

The programme concluded with a warm **vote of thanks** delivered by **Dr. Saurabh Kumar**, Chief Student Advisor (CSA). Dr. Kumar extended his heartfelt gratitude to **Prof. K.K. Khare** for his enlightening and motivational address, which connected the past to the present
