# CHAPTER-III METHODOLOGY

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## **METHODOLOGY**

### 3.1.0 INTRODUCTION

The methodology chapter provides a comprehensive overview of the research design, sampling techniques, data collection tools, procedures, and analysis methods used to investigate the environmental awareness and attitude of middle school students in Kendrapara district, Odisha. This descriptive survey research is grounded in quantitative methods to gather, analyse, and interpret data systematically.

### 3.2.0 METHODOLOGY

Descriptive Survey Method was employed for the study.

This study conducted in two phases for both middle school teachers and students. Before going to collect the data, researcher developed the questionnaire for attitude and awareness for both students and teachers. Questions are related to daily life and some are from the bookie's knowledge. Questions for teachers were related to their teaching skills and classroom activity. In first step, a questionnaire was provided to each student and teachers for awareness test which include some general knowledge of environment. In second step, researcher provided the questionnaire of attitude test for both teachers and students. It included questions of daily life activities which conducted in classroom.

# 3.3.0 POPULATION AND SAMPLE OF THE PRESENT STUDY

The population and the sample taken for the study is presented as under.

### 3.3.1 POPULATION

The middle school students and the teachers of Kendrapara district, Odisha were the population and sample, respectively, for the study.

### **3.3.2 SAMPLE**

Random sampling technique was employed for the study. Twenty Middle schools of Kendrapara, Odisha were selected for the study. As the study was related to the Middle school teacher and the students, so 50 teachers (23females, 27 males) and 200 students, including 108 girls and 92 boys, were the sample for the study. The details description of the sample is given in Table – 3.1.
