Capacity Building of Key Resource Persons on Nurturing and Enrichment of Talents of Gifted Students at Middle stage.

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The school functionaries seldom offer an opportunity in school to promote the talent and creative potential of gifted students. Such opportunities are needed to shape promising future of the student community and in triggering their imagination, talent and creative ideas. In this context there is a greater need for the general guidance, counselling and capacity building of school functionaries (KRPs) working at this level of the development of gifted students to facilitate, and promote their talent in the class or school. This would ultimately help and support them not only in nurturing and enrichment of talents of these students but also facilitate development of desired values, attitude and aptitude to enable the students to face the challenges of 21st century. Talents need differential educational programmes beyond those normally provided by the regular school programme in order to realize their contribution to self and society. If the talents of such learners are not recognized, nurtured and enriched further it would be not only loss to the person but also to the society. NEP 2020 also recommends about it.

Functionaries working for middle (elementary) school stage of Maharashtra state would constitute the target group for the orientation/training. Discussion, demonstration, transaction of materials, and sharing of experiences would be emphasized for conducting the programme. Print and non-print materials may be used. Evaluation may be through feedback from the participants for the improvement of such programmes in future.

It is in this direction a need based programme entitled, "Capacity Building of Key Resource Persons on Nurturing and Enrichment of Talents of Gifted Students at Middle stage" has been organised for the State of Maharashtra from 20-24 February, 2023 at RIE, Bhopal.

The specific objectives are to build capacities of KRPs:

- (i) on Nurturing Talents of Gifted Students at Middle (elementary) stage,
- (ii) on Enrichment of Talents of Gifted Students at Middle (elementary) stage.

The major areas of concerns and the discussion would be around the topics such as,

Art Integrated Education, Linguistic, Science and mathematics, vocational education and career counselling, Games and sports, values, Assessment/evaluation of talent, Inclusive settings, and 21st century skills or any other as emerged during the discussion.

I hope that the outcome of the programme will provide direction to the KRPS to promote the talents of the learners in schools.

Brief Report PAC Programme (Code No. 23.30/23.15)

PAC programme titled, “Capacity Building of Key Resource Persons on Nurturing and Enrichment of Talents of Gifted Students at Middle school stage” for the state of Maharashtra (code No. 23.30/23.15) was organized from 20-24, February, 2023 at Regional Institute of Education, Bhopal. The training programme was attended by a total number of 25 KRPs of Maharashtra state. The resource persons from within the Institute and outside discussed in detail about various aspects related to nurturing and enrichment of talents of gifted students at middle schools stage. Some of the related key areas discussed during the training programme were as follows:

Art Integrated Education, Linguistics, Science education, vocational education and career selection and counselling, Guidance and counselling, use of Library / Learning Resource Centre, Physical and Health Education, Assessment/ evaluation of talent, Talents of gifted in Inclusive settings, STEM and STEAM in India, 21st century skills and some other areas as emerged during the discussion.

It was privilege for the group to have Prof. Jaydip Mandal Principal of the Institute and Prof. Chitra Singh Head DEE in the inaugural session. They threw light on the importance and nature of such programme and about the significance of nurturing and enrichment of the talents of the gifted students at middle school stage in the light of NEP 2020. They also emphasized that such type of capacity building programmes for the teachers/ teacher educators will help the state in dealing with talentedness and giftedness at school level. Further Dr. Chughtai briefed them about the training programme and said, if we have to achieve the quality education, we need to

implement NEP 2020 recommendations in regular schools effectively. This training programme would include five working days comprising of 20 sessions. The whole training would emphasise on participatory and experiential approach to learning and encourages demonstration, discussion, group work, individual work etc. and the continuous evaluation of the trainees as well as the resource persons along with materials, processes and outcomes. There would be one thing special about the training that each one of the participant has to take up the responsibility of one's own learning. The participants were given the following tips.

You have to listen to the speakers carefully.

You have to share your own views and experiences with the group.

You have to raise your voice if you disagree.

You have to relate course content and discussion to your own situations and requirements, and

Make the learning meaningful, reflective and inclusive.

They realised the need and importance of educating such students in schools. The materials discussed during the training programme and their soft copies provided would be of great help to all of them. They said we all have now developed insight and confidence in how to educate and handle such children in schools and this would help us in organizing training programme for teachers and other functionaries in the state. They extended their thanks to the programme coordinator, resource faculty and authorities of RIE, Bhopal for organizing such a need based programme. They all expressed special thanks for the authorities of RIE for taking initiative and making all sorts of arrangements for them.

Prof. J. Mandal who was Programme Director also and Prof Chitra Singh Head DEE also addressed to the participants. Both of them emphasized on the timely intervention and said that such type of programmes are the need of the hour and would be of great significance for the state. Dr. Chitra Singh also thanked all the concerned authorities of Maharashtra state for the deputation of the participants and in making this programme a success.
